### AND THERE'S MORE...



A principal of a primary school in Brisbane stated that the most solid evidence they had of how their local Kids Hope heroes were making an impact, was in relation to how many misbehaviour conduct slips were brought to her office by offending students.

She shared that before Kids Hope started, there were 900 misbehaviour slips for the year. The year the program was introduced, this reduced to 300 slips. The following year, at the end of Term 1, there were only 30 slips. **That's almost an 85% reduction in misbehaviour!** 

She thanked the local church for making such a profound difference in the life of their school - directly attributing this remarkable change to the 26 dedicated Kids Hope mentors.

What a remarkable difference our treasured mentors can make! And the ripple effect that our program can have on the families and communities surrounding these mentored kids is immeasurable!
