

2018 Monash Evaluation Report

Excerpts



Teachers overwhelmingly believed that the Kids Hope (KH) program was having a positive impact on the health and wellbeing of the child with 95% of teachers indicating that they either strongly agreed or agreed with this statement and 99.5% of teachers saying they would recommend KH for other students.

The child enjoys being with the mentor

Almost all of the teachers (97%) strongly agreed or agreed that the child looked forward to meeting with their mentor each week and repeatedly talked about their sense of anticipation.

"The KH program has been fantastic for my student. They have continued to build a wonderful relationship together and my student eagerly awaits the session each week." – Teacher

"The excitement of having someone special coming to visit him makes his week. I know that he will never miss a Thursday at school because he cherishes the time they spend together." – Teacher

Emotional Wellbeing

86% of teachers strongly agreed or agreed that KH had improved the self-esteem and confidence of the child.

"He has gained more confidence. He read a poem in front of his whole class. This was a great step forward for him." – Mentor

"He has had a very sad home life and this mentoring program has helped his confidence and self-esteem." – Teacher

The majority of teachers (75%) agreed that KH had improved the child's ability to demonstrate resilience when facing challenges at school, with several discussing the development of these skills.

"The student is more resilient – he accepts challenges and has made strong friendships." – Teacher

Social Wellbeing

Many mentors described improvements in the child's ability to engage in positive interactions with 82% either strongly agreeing or agreeing that they had seen progress in this area.



"The KH program has encouraged the student to ask questions confidently and interact with other students and teachers with ease." – Teacher

"The student involved in the program has built a positive relationship with his mentor. This has developed his confidence and resulted in his ability to create positive relationships with students in his year." – Teacher

Impacts on Child Behaviour

74% of teachers agreed or strongly agreed that the behaviour of the child had improved over the course of the program and several made comments about their behaviour.

"He is now confident in communicating his concerns or when he is becoming anxious before letting his action take control (in the) classroom setting." – Teacher

The Child Experiences Success

Another key impact of the KH program was that of the child experiencing success.

Research into resilience in young people notes the importance of opportunities for success as a key protective factor.

Teachers and mentors both mentioned the pride children expressed in the tasks they were able to accomplish with their mentor:

"(He's) proud of what he achieves with his mentor."

Teachers' Experiences of the Program

Teachers reported the following observations and experiences of the Kids Hope program:

- 98% of teachers surveyed either 'strongly agreed' or 'agreed' that students looked forward to meeting with their mentor each week.
- 94% of teachers surveyed either 'strongly agreed' or 'agreed' that the student would benefit from participating in the KH program next year.





- 99% of teachers surveyed indicated that they would recommend the KH program for other students.
- 97% of teachers surveyed either 'strongly agreed' or 'agreed' that the KH program is easily implemented into the school setting.
- 96% of teachers surveyed either' strongly agreed' or 'agreed' that they felt supported by the KH volunteers, including the coordinator and mentor.
- 97% of teachers indicated that they believed the Kids Hope program had a positive impact on the health and wellbeing of the mentored student.
