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

Recently we asked Lynette what she had learnt from her mentor child. She replied, "Patience...and rugby!"

This superstar, young senior was ready to embrace change. So when Nico, her grade 4 mentor child, asked her to play his favourite sport... she said, "YES!" Little did she know it was rugby!

First, she learnt how to kick the ball and then she learnt how to pass. She said she can see the appreciation on Nico's face when she spends time doing what makes him happy. His parents do shift work and care for 2 boys with ADHD so they don't have a lot of spare time or energy to spend with their active children.

Since Lynette has been spending time with Nico, including playing rugby, she says he seems more focused and calm. She is so proud that he can now finish a book on his own after some initial literacy challenges.

All it took was for one caring mentor to be open and willing to learn from her young mentor child. That's generational impact right there! Thank you, Lynette, you really are a good sport!
